Team Preparation Guidelines

Teams should bring a laptop computer for use of each team member. Laptops should contain an office application, a graphic application, a text coding environment such as NotePad, NotePad++, TextPad++, or other basic text coding application (BootStrap or similar). In addition each team should include examples of code for layouts, code for such things as client-side basic shopping cart, image gallery, catalog, form, menus, calendar, navigation, timer, etc. anything they feel may be required to be included in the project. Bring lots of creative thinking and coding skills. Only HTML5, CSS, and JavaScript will be used to create this website.

The website created must be portable, fit on the USB provided, and be fully functional from the USB drive provided. The website must be completely client-side (no server-side). The website must be visually appealing, easy to maintain. Mobile, and responsive design a plus. Site users will range from those having the latest technologies and high-speed broadband connections to those who have old browsers and dial-up connections.

Website required will be 5 pages minimum, contain images, text, etc. (see above) for a fictional non-profit organization.
